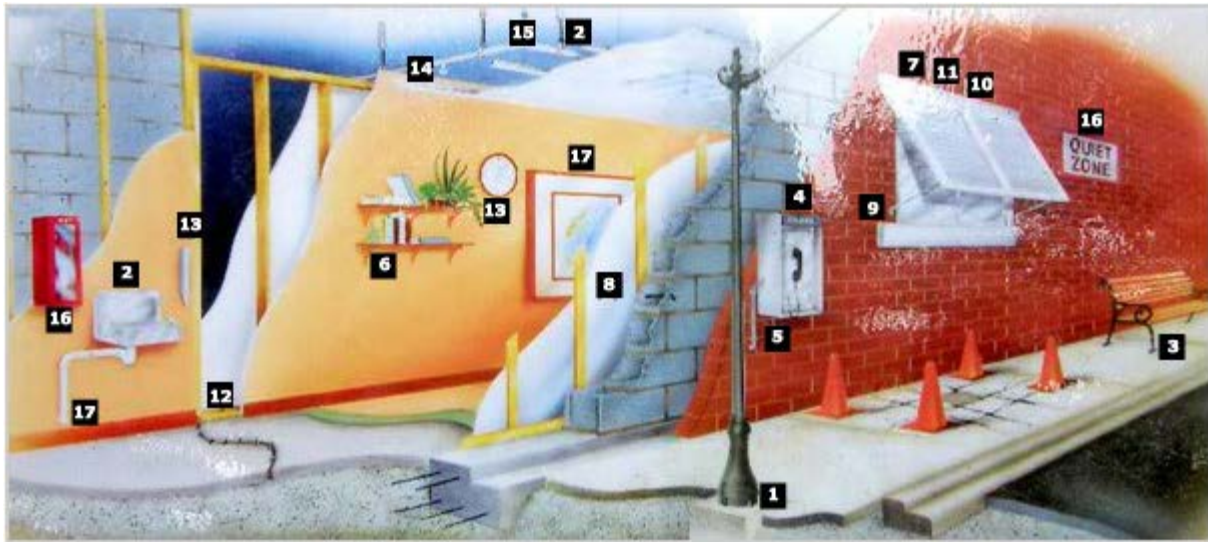


# Fastener Product Usage Chart



1. One-piece expansion bolt for heavy-duty applications sold in concrete or stone. Available in carbon steel, 304 & 316 stainless steel & galvanized.
2. Medium-duty anchor available in many head styles. Use in concrete, brick, stone or hollow block. Also available in stainless steel.
3. Flush style anchor with an internal plug for heavy duty applications in solid concrete or stone. Use with machine screw or bolt.
4. Caulking type anchor with zinc alloy cone for lead ring. For medium-duty use with machine screw or bolt in concrete or stone.
5. Concrete Screw Anchor – For medium to light duty applications in concrete, brick or block. Hex or flat head with corrosive resistant coating.
6. Fully-threaded machine screws with toggle wings for medium-duty fastening in hollow walls.
7. Zinc alloy anchor with either steel or stainless nail for medium-duty use in concrete, brick, block or stone. Tamperproof.
8. For light Duty fastening in hollow walls. Can be expanded with setting tool or screwdriver.
9. Rustproof zinc alloy anchor for light to medium-duty applications in concrete, brick, block or motor joint. Use with lag bolt.
10. Rustproof zinc alloy anchor for use in concrete, block, stone or brick. For medium-duty use with machine screw or bolt.
11. Rustproof zinc alloy anchor for use in concrete, block, stone or brick. Works well in soft masonry or in mediums of unknown strength. For medium-duty use with machine screw or bolt.
12. This nail-in type anchor is easily hammered into a pre-drilled hole for medium to light-duty use in concrete or stone.
13. This light-duty plastic anchor is used with sheet metal screws in drywall, block, brick or concrete. Also available in kits packaged with screws and a drill bit.
14. This anchor has a nylon body and steel pin. For light-duty use in concrete, block, brick, stone and wallboard.
15. Fasten to expansion anchors or threaded rod that has already been installed. For pipe hanging or tied down applications.
16. Nylon anchors used with coarse thread screws for light to medium use in concrete, block, brick or stone.
17. Available in zinc or nylon for light-duty use in drywall. Use with a #8 sheet metal screw.
